Based in SoCal, Southbound and Company performs classic rock music all across the country. Members of the band include Darryl Reed (lead vocals), Michael Finn (lead guitar), Mike Hunter (drums), Kevin Haerr-Bass (guitar), Steve Gauronski (lead guitar), and Shaun N Bernadou (backup vocals).
