THREE DOG NIGHT TRIBUTE DEBUTS AT HHT

On Saturday September 24th, the Historic Hemet Theatre hosted a special Tribute to Three Dog Night featuring 3DN. Close friends Bradley Ford, Dave Alcantar and John Gebhardt have played the music of Three Dog Night for ten years, but each performer has been heavily involved in other projects and in recent years the 3DN band fell by the wayside.

Ford has performed twice at HHT with Fortunate Son, his Tribute to Creedence Clearwater Revival, which will return again in November this year. Meanwhile, with the urging of HHT and local fans, Ford gathered together the 3DN show to begin performing again. The Hemet performance was the group's first show with their new backup musicians.

Hemet's avid Three Dog Night fans were not disappointed. The crowd clapped and cheered every classic hit, singing along with the band. The show was not sold out, but the dance floor was full most of the night, from the slowest ballad to the fastest rock beat. At the end of the night, the whole audience was cheering, "Joy to the World!"

After the show the band drew scores of fans for photos in front of the theatre. Nothing but rave reviews (as usual) for the latest Tribute Mania show at the Historic Hemet Theatre.
