FOREIGNER TRIBUTE THRILLS THE CROWD AT HHT

Kyle Frost and his band, 4NR, hit the stage at the Historic Hemet Theatre with their high-energy tribute to Foreigner on Saturday October 20th. Kyle is a big fan of Hemet's old movie house. In fact, it is his favorite venue to play. "The auditorium has great acoustics which makes for great music. But when you add in hundreds of cheering fans, there is just nothing like it," Kyle explained.

The music of Foreigner is some of the most difficult rock music to perform live in concert, but these guys make it look easy. It is no wonder that the band has earned a place as one of the best, appearing on AXTV's "World's Greatest Tribute Bands" in Season Five.

For Saturday's show, several songs featured animated graphics on the movie screen behind the band, including flames, ice cubes and a juke box. As usual, the dance floor quickly filled with fans, rocking to the beat from the first song to the last. 4NR is one of HHT's most requested bands and once again they delivered with a performance that was both energetic and nostalgic. Afterwards, the band posed for photos and autographs on the dance floor and in the lobby. This event attracted a large number of "newbies" to the theatre, excited to find such a high caliber of entertainment so close to home.

Meanwhile, tickets for the rest of the Tribute Mania Concert Series are going fast. Tickets for the Tribute to Creedence Clearwater Revival with Fortunate Son on November 3rd are already gone. Less than 100 tickets remain for each event in the rest of the season, which includes Tribute to Neil Diamond with Dean Colley and Hot August Night (Nov 17), Tribute to Queen featuring Queen Nation (Dec 8), and Cash, Killer and the King: a tribute to Johnny Cash, Jerry Lee Lewis and Elvis (Dec 15). The schedule for the next season, starting in January 2019, will be announced at the November 3rd concert.

Showtime for all Tribute Mania concerts is 7:00 pm, with doors open at 6:15 pm. Tickets are \$22 presale / \$25 day of show.
