TICKETS FOR NEIL DIAMOND TRIBUTE NEARLY GONE

The last time Dean Colley brought his Tribute to Neil Diamond to Hemet, the last few tickets sold out at the door. This time when the "Hot August Night" band arrives on Saturday November 17th, there will be no tickets left to be found. With 2 weeks left before the event, there are fewer than 50 tickets remaining.

Dean Colley and his showcase band, Hot August Night, are known across the country as the #1 tribute to the music of Neil Diamond. Dean Colley's sound-alike and look-alike tribute performance includes everything from the classic 60s to contemporary Neil Diamond hits.

The show is a musical journey celebrating the legacy of Neil Diamond, featuring over 30 classic hits, including "Sweet Caroline," "Song Sung Blue," "Holly Holy," "Forever in Blue Jeans," "Cracklin Rosie," "America," "Cherry Cherry," and many more.
