QUEEN NATION BRINGS LONG-AWAITED TRIBUTE TO HHT

Queen fans in town had anticipated that Queen Nation would perform their dynamic tribute show at HHT in August, but a mix-up with the booking agent forced the show to be postponed. Tickets were exchanged for a new date while anticipation grew. Adding to the excitement, a new film, "Bohemian Rhapsody," has been released, portraying the rise of Freddie Mercury and Queen as one of the most powerful and iconic groups in the history of rock music.

So it is not surprising that the Tribute to Queen on Saturday December 8th has been sold out for several weeks. Queen Nation has a particularly passionate fan club, which will bring dozens of patrons from across Southern California to Hemet's vintage movie house.
