TRIBUTE TO THE DOORS ANOTHER SELL OUT AT HHT

Fans of Jim Morrison and The Doors packed the house at the Historic Hemet Theatre on Saturday April 27th for a wild tribute performance by STRANGE DAYS.

Even before the band took the stage, the party atmosphere was electric. Dozens of "newbies" were on hand, soon to discover the reason that most concerts at the downtown arts center are selling out.

The cheering began as Lead singer Jason Tosta took the stage, leaping and twirling as the first notes of "Break On Through" filled the room. Then with every song the cheering continued, through "Light My Fire," "Riders on the Storm," "L.A. Woman" and so many classic Doors hits.

Throughout the night, the dance floor was filled with dancers, many reliving their youth when Morrison and The Doors took the country by storm with their heavy metal rock.

After the show there were lots of the newbies at the foot of the stage to meet the band and rave about their HHT concert experience. Later, the line at the ticket office left no doubt on the verdict... dozens of new fans for Hemet's vintage movie house.

Tribute to The Doors was the last concert in Season One of the Tribute Mania Concert Series. Season Two begins on May 11th with a Tribute to Bon Jovi featuring WANTED. Other concerts in the series include tributes to The Allman Brothers (5/25), Bob Seger (6/8), Santana (6/22), Led Zeppelin (7/6), Aerosmith (7/20), REO Speedwagon (8/3), and Tom Petty (8/17).

Upcoming concerts in the Friday Nite Live series include tributes to Creedence Clearwater Revival (5/31), and Johnny Cash (6/14).
