On Saturday May 25th, fans of the Allman Brothers converged on downtown Hemet for the premier appearance by RAMBIN' MAN at the Historic Hemet Theatre.

The holiday weekend crowd was unusually light, but the energy level in the auditorium felt like a full house. The band kept the fans clapping and cheering from start to finish, clearly demonstrating why they are considered the premier tribute band for the classic sound of the Allman Brothers. Dozens of dancers flocked to the dance floor to catch a closer look at the stunning guitar riffs and moving to the beat provided by the groups two drummers.
