For over 10 years, "Turn the Page" has toured the nation, faithfully recreating all the classic Bob Seger hits. You will feel as though you’ve been transported back to Detroit’s Cobo Hall as you relive "Old Time Rock and Roll," "Night Moves," "Against The Wind," "Hollywood Nights," "We've Got Tonight," "You'll Accompany Me," and "Like a Rock," -- they way they were meant to be experienced....live in concert!

Based in Southern California, "Turn the Page" has appeared on AXTV World’s Greatest Tribute Bands and has sold over 750,000 downloads of their tribute CDs. "Turn the Page" is band members Sam Morrison (vocals, guitars), Bart Robley

(drums), Greg Kasparian (bass), Karl Sanger (saxophone), Walt Thompson (keyboards) and David Kurtz (guitar).
